SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM--RULES AND REGULATIONS

Jednosc, Lodge 513, Polish National Alliance, Inc. is pleased to make available scholarships to qualified members who will be enrolled as full time college or university students in the fall semester.

1. Incoming Freshmen, Sophomores, Juniors and Seniors attending or scheduled to attend an accredited college or university on a "full time" basis will be eligible to apply.
2. There are two options for eligibility in this scholarship program:
 - A. Will require the applicant to be a member in good standing of the PNA for at least one year. Applicants in order to qualify for this scholarship MUST have a premium paying permanent plan of insurance as listed herin: Whole Life, Universal Life, Executive Life Paid Up @ 90, Life Paid Up[@ 65, 20 Pay Life or a single Premium whole Life Policy in the amount of \$10,000.00 coverage.
 - B. Grandparents, parents, step parents and Social Members, who are Active Members in Good Standing within Lodge 513, of a child not a member of the Lodge, having completed 60 hours of Documented and Verified Volunteer Work for the Lodge, may enter the child's application. This should NOT be hours associated with an elective or appointed position. (ex: custodian, bartender)
3. The completed application must be received by Lodge 513 no later than June 15, 2024.
4. The application must include the following:
 - a. A completed application signed by the applicant, parent, and Lodge President and Financial Secretary.
 - b. Most recent transcript must be attached to application. Without the transcript, the application is incomplete and therefore, will be **DISQUALIFIED**.
 - c. A recent photograph (wallet size please) if available.
 - d. A copy of the letter of acceptance or continuing education from the college or university the applicant will be attending.
5. Scholarships will be awarded for studies and programs only in U.S. Colleges and Universities.
6. In determining the recipients, the Scholarship Committee will take into consideration the applicants Academic records, Educational goals, Involvement in Fraternal and Youth Activities of the PNA as well as Family PNA membership, Church, Community and School activities.
7. Recipients of the scholarships will be notified of the Committee's decision by June 25, 2024.
8. Applicants are advised that any false or misleading information or statement may result in permanent disqualification from participation in the PNA Scholarship Program.
9. Anyone awarded this particular scholarship, will NOT be eligible to apply or be awarded a financial benefit from this fund again during their collegiate period. This is a ONE TIME award for either a graduating high school senior or a college Freshmen, Sophomore, Junior or Senior.
